<b>Preliminary/ Training (P/T)</b>	Designed for competitors preparing to move up to Preliminary level. It will follow recognized horse trial rules.	USEF 2018 Preliminary Test A	--Same as Training Course, see below 3'3" max	3'7" max, includes 1 triple combination.
<b>Open Training (OT)</b>	Designed for competitors who have completed at least 2 novice level horse trials, follows recognized HT rules.	USEF 2018 Training Test A	2250m, 20-24 jumps. 3'3" max, 400mpm. W Water, ditch, & banks.	3'3" max, includes 1 triple or 2 doubles.

<b>Beginner Novice (BN)</b>	Designed for new competitors, or for those who have competed at the Hopeful before, or BN horse trials.	USEF 2018 Beginner Novice Test A	2000m, 14-16 jumps. 2'7" max, 320mpm. Water, ditch, & up bank.	2'7" max, may include one 2-stride combination.
<b>Starter* (Start)</b> *new name	Designed for first time competitors with some jumping experience. Lead riders allowed on the XC phase.	USEF 2018 Beginner Novice Test A	1500m, 8-10 jumps. 2'3" max.	2'3" max, no combinations.
<b>Green as Grass (new!) (GG)</b>	Designed for first time competitors, and may not need jumping experience for this level! Lead riders allowed.	USDF 2015 Introductory Level Test A	1200m max, 6-8 jumps. 18" max, all logs.	18" max, ground poles and cross rails.

Combined Test jumping at end of each equivalent HT division

2pm Cross-Country Jumping; run from highest down (Training to Green as Grass)

<b>Awards:</b>	HT: Ribbons to 8 <sup>th</sup> , prizes to 3 <sup>rd</sup> . CT: Ribbons to 8 <sup>th</sup> , prizes to 1 <sup>st</sup> . Dressage Tests: Ribbons to 5 <sup>th</sup> . The Hopeful is part of the <u>MiniEvent Triple Crown Series!</u> Check paradisecreek.ponyclub.org for info.
<b>Rules:</b>	Current USEF & USPC Rules for Eventing will be followed, though some latitude will be made for the unrecognized event. Ask organizer if you have specific questions.
<b>Lead Riders:</b>	Lead riders for cross-country are intended for the assistance of inexperienced riders (i.e. D1 and D2 level Pony Clubbers) in the Starter and Green as Grass divisions. Lead riders may or may not be available for all riders requesting them (bring your own?) we will do our best to provide a fun and safe experience for our new event riders! Leads are intended for green riders, not green horses.
<b>Refunds:</b>	Before the closing date, less \$15 (office fee). After closing date, less \$25, and only upon receipt of veterinarian or medical doctor's note.
<b>Pinneys:</b>	Non-returned pinney fee: \$25.
<b>Starting Times:</b>	Approximate start times available on-line Tuesday, June 26 <sup>th</sup> . Final start times on grounds Friday, June 29 <sup>th</sup> at 3pm. Call (208) 877-1381. Check: paradisecreek.ponyclub.org
<b>Directions:</b>	From the west; Deary, Idaho is 30 miles east of Moscow, ID on Highway 8. Pony Club grounds 3 miles east of Deary (on HWY 8) on the N side of the highway. Look for signs.
<b>Nature of Terrain:</b>	Wooded, rolling hills.
<b>Accommodations:</b>	Camping on grounds, no hook-ups. Hotels available in Moscow, ID. Camping fee of \$10 per night per camping unit (i.e. tent = 1 unit, or camper on truck = 1 unit) Contact organizer with questions.
<b>Stabling:</b>	We have upgraded! Nearly all stalls are 12x12 pole stalls (not covered) on grounds. \$15/night, or \$15 for day stall use. Check in at office for stall assignments. Bedding not provided, and please only shavings (no straw) if bringing your own.
<b>Concessions:</b>	<b>NOT available</b> Please pre-purchase meals on entry form → <b>Meal tickets;</b> Option X: Fri dinner, Sat breakfast & lunch (\$25). Option Y: Fri dinner THRU Sunday breakfast (\$40). Option Z: Sat lunch (\$8)
<b>Other:</b>	An interstate certificate of veterinary inspection (Health Certificate) is <b>required</b> for travel between Idaho, Oregon & Washington, as well as a current EIA (Coggins) test. Brand Inspections are HIGHLY recommended as we have had brand inspectors come to our camps in the past, and fine participants who did not have correct paperwork with them. <b><u>Please bring your horse paperwork with you to camp, but we are not requiring copies of them with your entry form.</u></b>

*A parent or guardian must sign if the competitor is under 18 years of age.*
